Option #1—Helix Necklace

Delicate and sparkly, the Helix necklace features a set of intricate looking spiralling components arranged in a flattering Y-shape. Using an unexpected method to create a twisted base, each helix component is adorned with a dazzling array of crystal bicones before being connected to a unique open ring element. The fun spiral components can be easily adapted in size to make perfect co-ordinating earrings to complete a matched set of jewellery.

This project is suitable for all levels of beaders with experience of Right Angle Weave.

The “In Case You Missed It” option offers you the chance to take a project you might have missed first time around. Your choices are CRAW Donut, Russian Rings, Eleganza and Dragon’s Nest.

Stanwick Lakes is a unique 750 acre countryside attraction and nature reserve located in the heart of Northamptonshire's Nene Valley. There are extensive and imaginative play areas, open spaces and paths that families, walkers, cyclists and nature lovers can explore at leisure. The visitor centre, with café, shop and function space, hosts events, family celebrations, business meetings and craft workshops throughout the year. Stanwick Lakes is managed as a social enterprise by environmental charity, Rockingham Forest Trust, in partnership with East Northamptonshire Council.

Parking Charges

Admission is charged for through a variable car parking charge. The site is free to those who walk or cycle in. Please note that the pay machines accept cash only (change is given).

Every time you pay the car park charges at Stanwick Lakes you are supporting the conservation and maintenance work that takes place on the site. This includes managing the nature reserve for wildlife, looking after the play equipment and maintaining miles of paths for walking and cycling.
